Identify a road with no pavement					
Be aware to always walk on a pavement if available rather than a road					
Identify which side of the road to walk on if no pavement is available					
Identify that you must stand in a safe position while cars pass by					
Be aware that some roads may not have street lights					
Be aware that you should always wear reflective clothing when walking on roads with no pavement					
Activity 10					
Stand safely at a bus stop without disrupting other people waiting					
Select a safe route to a named bus stop					
Stand back until the bus pulls up					
Wait until any passengers to alight					
Carefully step up on the bus					
Tell the bus driver where they are going					
Give the driver money / bus pass					
Wait until driver gives ticket					
Ask driver to inform candidate when stop is near					
Behave appropriately whilst on a bus					
Watch for selected stop and get ready to get off					
Wait until the bus fully stops					
Hold onto bus rails					
Step down off a bus safely					
Move directly away from the bus and on to the kerb					
Wait until the bus has completely moved away					
Use Green Cross Code to Cross road					
Order a private taxi					
Inform someone of the intended destination and taxi firm					
Tell driver the destination and ask how much the journey will cost					
Be aware of personal safety					
Pay the driver the correct fare					
Enter the taxi correctly					
Identify a possible emergency that may happen					
Identify what they would do if an emergency happened
